**CHAPEL**: Our mission offerings for the first quarter will be used for our synod's Christian Aid Relief program. The offering this past week was \$59.60. Our total for the quarter is now \$290.80. This was our final offering of the first quarter. A check will soon be sent out. Our 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter mission project is the Christian Life Resource Center in Saginaw. This agency counsels women against abortion and then serves as a support group when they choose life. Encourage your child to bring an offering each Wednesday.

**CHILDREN'S CHRISTMAS SERVICE**: The Board of education has decided that due to COVID restrictions the Children's Christmas Service scheduled for Thursday, December 17, 2020 has been canceled.

CALENDAR CHANGES: I have several calendar changes to report at this time. Because of COVID concerns and the desire to create more space between the holidays when people expand their contacts, Thanksgiving and Christmas vacations have been extended. There will be no school on Monday, November 30, 2020 and Tuesday December 1, 2020. School will resume after Thanksgiving with a full day of classes on Wednesday, December 2<sup>nd</sup>. There will be <u>no</u> school on Monday, January 4 and Tuesday, January 5, 2021. School will resume after Christmas with a full day of classes on Wednesday, January 6, 2021.

Since the Children's Christmas Service has been canceled it has been decided to add back in December 18, 2020 on the school calendar. We will also have a full day of school on Thursday, December 17<sup>th</sup>, and will add in Friday December 18<sup>th</sup> as a <u>half day</u> with dismissal at noon after room Christmas parties. All calendar changes have been placed on our school Google Calendar. I will also be sending home a revised paper calendar which includes all the changes here mentioned. All of these changes will not affect the total number of school days in our calendar. You might remember that back in October we added three days of class on to our school year when the Michigan District Teachers' conference was canceled and we just added a day of school on December 18, 2020. The days that were added in (4) negate the additional days (4) of vacation after Thanksgiving and Christmas.
