Mission Program: Our 2nd quarter mission offering will go to the Central African Medical Mission (CAMM). This ministry brings not only the gospel to places in Africa but also much needed medical and physical care also. Members of CAMM will be coming to give a school presentation about the CAMM on Wednesday, December 7th during chapel. Parents and congregation members are invited to join us for that presentation. Our first week's offering totaled \$60.85. This is a great opportunity for children to contribute to the mission work of our church and synod. The Ladies Aid has also offered to match the chapel offerings that are given by the kids. This is a fantastic way for us to work together as a congregation to help spread the gospel around the world!

Playground Update: Wow! There is A LOT that has taken place with our playground in the last week! The playground is almost complete. Over the weekend we were able to put together and install almost all of the playground structure. There are still a few things that need to be done to finish off the playground before the kids will be allowed to use it. After we have totally finished the installation the next step will be to have the playground inspector inspect the playground for approval.

It is a tremendous blessing, when undertaking a project like this, to have people step up to help out.
