Adult Co-Ed Volleyball Tournament

The Michigan Lutheran Seminary Adult Co-Ed Volleyball Tournament will be on Saturday, April 13 and will begin between 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. depending on the number of teams.

The main purpose of this tournament is to better acquaint church members with your ministerial education training school and its students, as well as the facilities, while also serving as a fundraiser for Michigan Lutheran Seminary. Money raised will go the MLS general fund.

- We will take entries from congregations of the WELS and ELS. Congregations may enter multiple teams in the tournaments.
- A player should be a member of the congregation for which he/she is playing. They should not be members of any other church, especially if that congregation also has a team participating in the tournament.
- If a congregation does not have enough interested players for the tournament, we would encourage you to contact congregations nearby to see if combining your efforts could result in a team for the tournament.
- Participants are to be of confirmation age or older.

Any exceptions to these rules must be cleared by the tournament director prior to registering for the tournament. A team entry fee of \$100.00 per team will be charged this year. The payment will be due at registration time and will be paid online. The registration deadline is Saturday April 6th.
